Poster Competition on Historic Building of Rawalpindi

Within the framework of UNESCO-NFIT-WHITRAP-NCA Project on Developing Guidelines on Adaptive Reuse of Historic Buildings in Rawalpindi a poster competition amongst the students of the Government Schools was organized on June 22nd 2016 in collaboration with Education Directorate, Rawalpindi. The purpose of the event was to raise awareness and to understand and revisit the significance of historic buildings to the present culture of Rawalpindi.



It was a well-attended event with over 45 participants from different public schools. Provisions were also made for handicapped children to ensure their enthusiastic participation. The Jury under the leadership of Dr. Surraya Chaudhary Ph.D Fine Arts evaluated the posters. The prize distribution ceremony of the poster competition is scheduled in November 2016. The poster competition is a much-needed step in the direction of engaging the community in the repair, maintenance and adaptive reuse of historic buildings in Rawalpindi and may inspire future work through both the community and governance level.
