

Frequently Asked Questions for Call for Proposal

- Q. Is there a certain limit of Human Resource that you can acquire or use in the 7 months tenure in the project**
- A. There are no strict maximum or minimum human resources requirements for the project. As it involves the design and implementation of a specialized training programme focusing on the cultural and creative industries, and as your organization may not necessarily possess all relevant expertise, the need to outsource or engage relevant experts for this purpose may be required. Whether you choose to outsource this component of the project or not, a UNESCO expert will guide/contribute to the development of the course and delivery of the training. Keeping this in mind, UNESCO expects that the selected organization possess experience in providing incubation facilities and training and that the human resources requirements to successfully implement the project will be met
- Q. The project budget we are working on should it be in USDs or PKRs.**
- A. The budget needs to be in PKR
- Q. What is the budget bracket for the asked proposal? (If there is any)**
- A. As per UNESCO procedures this information cannot be provided, however the budget has to be as per resources required to deliver the TORs and achieve the required results as well as cost effective and according to the prevailing market prices
- Q. I wanted to ask whether there is a fixed sum allocated for the entire project or does that depend on our own budgeting.**
- A. Ans. It depends upon your own budgeting as per need of the TORs but until the limit of maximum allocation done by UNESCO for a certain component however as per policy that limit cannot be disclosed.
