

Frequently Asked Questions for RFP: [FO_CFP_05_2019_148]:

To engage organisation for mobilizing school going and out of school youth in safeguarding heritage.

Q. The tasks list mentions in point 2 and 4 the development of supplementary materials for teaching and interactive learning. Are these to be developed in English or there is a flexibility to have these developed in local languages (Urdu/ Sindhi)?

A. Resource and learning material for Phase I of the project is to be produced in Urdu and Sindhi.

Q. In point 5 of tasks list there is a mention of (at least) eight lower secondary/ secondary schools. What will be the criteria for shortlisting these schools? And what is the approximate area to be taken into consideration. Are there any statistics available on existing schools within the area being taken in consideration.

A. It is preferred that the selected organization engages schools located in the Union Councils where Makli necropolis and Shah Jahan Mosque are situated, and that a minimum of 75% of the schools engaged should be government schools. Statistical data can be obtained from the District Education Officer.

Q. In point 7 there is a mention of communities living around Makli - are these already identified? Or is there any statistics available on them?

A. The communities living in the vicinity of Makli have not been identified for the purpose of this project. The selected organization will be encouraged to engage communities living closest to the Makli necropolis, who interact with the site on a regular basis, and therefore have a direct link to it in their daily lives.

Q. For the training workshops mentioned in Phase II works - is there any limitation on duration of these?

A. Each capacity-building workshop can last up to 2-3 days.
