



Request for Proposals (Re-advertisement)
Construction of Transitional Shelters for Schools and Technical Vocational Workshops

UNESCO is building 5 semi-permanent school buildings and 4 semi-permanent technical vocational training workshops in Azad Jammu and Kashmir (AJK) and North-West Frontier Province (NWFP). For this purpose, UNESCO invites interested competent construction companies and I/NGOs to submit proposals.

The work is divided into two packages, one for AJK and another for NWFP. Each package includes both schools and workshops to be built in that region. Proposals for both packages should be submitted separately, as stated below.

Each proposal should be submitted in the following two parts:

- a. **Technical Proposal:** Two duly marked copies (“Original” and “Copy”) to be submitted as per the technical design and specifications given for schools and workshops in one sealed envelope.
- b. **Financial Proposal:** Two duly marked copies (“Original” and “Copy”) to be submitted in a separate sealed envelope.

Bank Guarantee @ 2.5% of quoted value in the form of Bank Draft must accompany the proposal failing which the proposal will be rejected. The rates should be quoted in Pak Rupees only. Conditional and incomplete proposals will not be accepted.

The proposals shall be properly sealed and addressed to **UNESCO, House No 17, Street # 8, F-7/3, P.O. Box 2034, Islamabad, Pakistan**; and clearly state: **“CONFIDENTIAL: PROPOSAL FOR SERVICES - DO NOT OPEN”**.
